

LIONS LICENSE PLATES



Indiana Lions are entitled to have the Lions emblem on their license plates. This is a way for Lions to make a statement that they are proud to be Lions and also to make other individuals aware of who the Lions are so that they can inquire about becoming a Lion.

The cost is an additional \$40.00 of which \$25.00 goes to the Indiana Lions Foundation for its philanthropic purposes and \$15.00 is a fee kept by the BMV.

If you are re-registering an automobile or motorcycle which already has a Lions plate and you use the form that is mailed to you, the renewal should be automatic.

If you are obtaining a plate for a different automobile or motorcycle, you should request a Lions Plate from the local License Branch. If they do not have one in stock, they are required to give you a temporary plate for up to sixty days while they order the new Lions plate which will be mailed to you.

The consent from the Indiana Lions Foundation is no longer a requirement.
